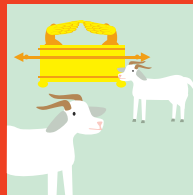

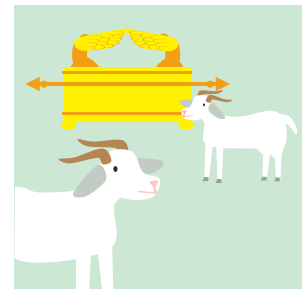


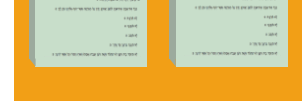
COVENANT PROMISE

Genesis 15; Romans 4





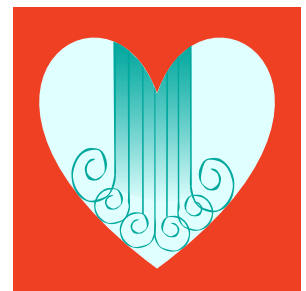
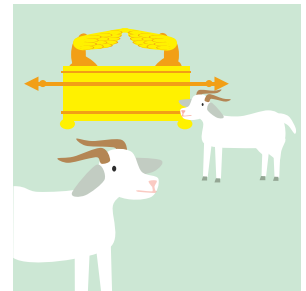
COVENANT NAME

Exodus 34:6-7; John 1:14-18





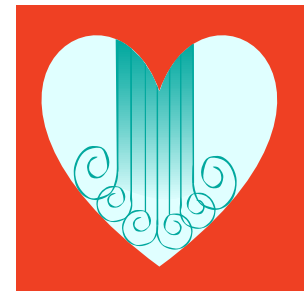
COVENANT HOLINESS

For the choir director. A Psalm of David, when Nathan the prophet came to him, after he had gone in to Bathsheba.

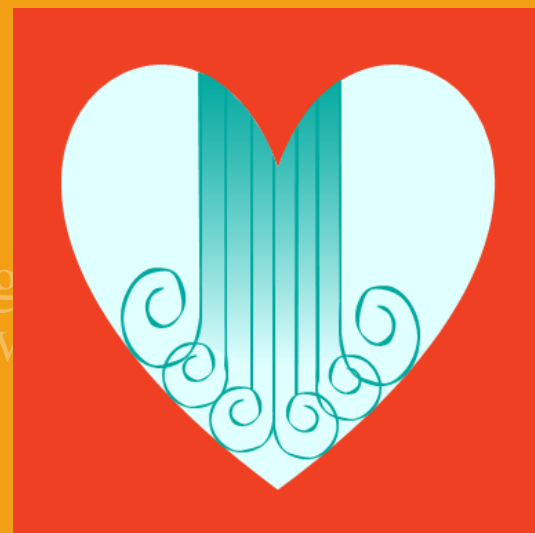
